### Instructions

Start reading at the very beginning of Genesis. When you find the short phrase for each day, write down the book, chapter, and verse in the blanks provided. The next day, continue reading from where you stopped the day before.

The distance you read to find each entry will vary. On average, it'll be about 85 verses per day, but it may occasionally be as short as 38, or as long as 129 verses.

When you reach the end of a book, check the top of the section to see which book you should start reading next. You'll jump back and forth between the Old and New Testaments, and between history, prophecy, and instruction. By the time you finish the entire booklet, you'll have read through the entire Bible once... all 31,102 verses of it.

All verses quoted are from the King James Version (KJV) of the Bible.

Do **not** use a concordance, computer, or anything else to help you find the verses.

Do **not** copy your answers from anyone else.

By quickly looking up the phrases in a concordance or computer, or by copying from someone else, you may cheat your way to a prize, but you'll also cheat yourself out of the benefits to your own soul.
