Instructions

Start reading at the beginning of Matthew. When you find the short phrase for each day, write down the verse in the blank provided. The next day, continue reading from where you stopped the day before.

The distance you read to find each entry will vary. Usually, it'll be about 16 verses per day, but it may occasionally be as short as 11, or as long as 21 verses.

When you reach the end of a book, check the next day to see which book you should start reading next. You'll jump back and forth between the Old and New Testaments, and between history and instruction. By the time you finish the entire booklet, you'll have read all the way through 17 different books of the Bible – that's 5,713 verses in all.
