When Caleb and Joshua returned from scouting out the land of Canaan, they spoke words of encouragement, reminding the people of the Lord's power and calling them to obey the Lord and to trust Him for deliverance from the people of the land: "The Lord is with us: fear them not." The other spies had a different message, though – they brought an evil report and spoke words of fear and defeat, warning the people that Canaan was "a land that eateth up the inhabitants thereof." What a contrast between what these two groups of men were saying – and what heartache and wanderings could have been avoided if the people had just listened to the words of Caleb and Joshua.

The Scripture Searchers are intended to help you establish a habit of setting aside time to spend with our Lord every day. May we each be found making this time in our lives for the Lord and for His word, and may we each be used of Him to faithfully encourage and exercise those around us.

Start reading at the beginning of Exodus.

Instructions

Start reading at the beginning of the book of Exodus. When you find the short phrase for each day, write down the chapter and verse in the blanks provided. The next day, continue reading from where you stopped the day before.

The distance you read to find each entry will vary. On average, it'll be about 43 verses per day, but it may occasionally be as short as 20, or as long as 68 verses.

When you reach the end of a book, check the next day to see which book you should start reading next. You'll jump back and forth between the Old and New Testaments, and between history, prophecy, and instruction. By the time you finish the entire booklet, you'll have read through over half of the Bible... 15,621 verses in all.
