From the opening pages of the Word of God, all the way through to the very end, we the enemy's attempts to minimize, distort, and justify sin – to make it accepted and normal. Even after witnessing the judgement and destruction that fell on Sodom, Lot still longed for just a little bit of the city he had grown so accustomed to. The lawyer in Luke that asked the Lord about his neighbor wasn't looking to find who he could help, but he was asking in an attempt to "justify himself" – to find a loophole that meant the law he had just quoted didn't actually apply to him.

We all know the power of sin in this world, and the hold it has over the old nature we all have. How often, though, do we find ourselves minimizing or excusing it? How often are we indifferent to the presence of sin around us just because it's become so common in the world that we walk through?

Start reading at the beginning of Romans.

Instructions

Start reading at the beginning of the book of Romans. When you find the short phrase for each day, write down the chapter and verse in the blanks provided. The next day, continue reading from where you stopped the day before.

The distance you read to find each entry will vary. On average, it'll be about 43 verses per day, but it may occasionally be as short as 22, or as long as 68 verses.

When you reach the end of a book, check the next day to see which book you should start reading next. You'll jump back and forth between the Old and New Testaments, and between history, prophecy, and instruction. By the time you finish the entire booklet, you'll have read through over half of the Bible... 15,567 verses in all.
